



Friedens Lutheran Church Recycling Center

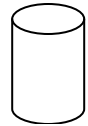
Friedens Lutheran Church and Burgmeier Hauling Inc. have partnered to develop a community recycling center in our rear parking lot, just off main street near the basketball court.

Many of our community members are avid recyclers, dedicated to preserving resources and practicing the three “R’s” – Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. For years they have been seeking a centralized location for recycling that will accept a wide variety of items. The Friedens Lutheran Church Recycling Center meets these needs and offers a convenient, easily accessible location for drop-offs and will accept several types of household generated recyclable items. Recycling is a responsible approach to conserving earth’s resources that God has given us.

Burgmeier Hauling, Inc. is providing the bins and recycling service as a community project for the Friedens area. The project is also supported by the Wells Creek Watershed. There is little, if any, profit to be made, but the rewards benefit the environment and earth’s resources. The Friedens Recycling Center will operate on a six month trial basis. If the bins are not misused and kept in order we will continue the service. The bins will be monitored...and of course God is also watching!

Can for Plastic Bags

There are three bins to accept recyclables. A stand-alone bin will accept cardboard while the second longer bin is partitioned into two compartments. The left side will accept newspaper, office paper, paperback books, phone books, junk mail etc. The right compartment has three access doors and will accept co-mingled tin cans, aluminum cans, glass bottles and jars of any color, and #1 & #2 plastic containers. Signs are posted on the top of the units by each door that explains the types of items that can be put in the bins. **We will not accept window glass, paint containers, hard back books, tin foil, styrofoam, or containers that have hazardous contents.** There is a latch on each bin to keep the doors closed to keep out weather and animals.

You do not have to sort the materials by type in the co-mingled bin, simply dump the glass, plastic, tin, and aluminum cans into the bin together. **Please remove recyclables from plastic bags or boxes you may use to transport the items in. Do not put plastic bags in any of the bins! Put bags in the can designated for plastic bags.** The items will eventually be sorted by Burgmeier Hauling and leaving the items in bags hinders the sorting process and could damage machinery. Please rinse all containers for sanitary reasons.

Bring your recyclables when you come to Church each Sunday! We welcome all to attend our services, programs, and to become a part of the Friedens Lutheran Church Community.
